Course Description This qualification reflects the roles of experienced practitioners delivering training and assessment services usually within Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) within the vocational education and training (VET) sector. They may have a role in leading other trainers and assessors and in providing mentoring or advice to new trainers or assessors as well as designing approaches to learning and assessment strategies across a significant area within the RTO.

- Group workshops supported by individual mentoring
- Quality distance delivery with individual mentoring and support
- RPL assessment with individual mentored support
- Gap Training

Cost

Student Fee will be calculated on registration/enrolment according to the Government Smart and Skilled funding calculation as follows:

- If it is your first qualification post School - **Estimated fee \$2,530**
- If it is your second or further qualification post School - **Estimated fee is \$2,850**

If you are eligible for Smart and Skilled training and you are:

- an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander student
- a student with a disability
- an Australian Government welfare recipient

You and your dependants may be eligible for a fee exemption or concession when enrolling in a Smart and Skilled course.

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Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification, however it is desirable that candidates are employed in a role where they have maintained currency within the VET (Vocational Education and Training) sector and have either TAE40110 or TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment.

Recommended Duration and Volume of Learning

The volume of learning for the Diploma of Vocational Education and Training as a Learning and Assessment pathway is typically 1 to 2 years (1200 – 2400 hours).

Articulation

On completion of this course you would be able to consider higher qualifications such as: TAE80316 Graduate Certificate in Digital Education, TAE80113 Graduate Diploma of Adult Language, Literacy and Numeracy Practice or TAE80213 Graduate Diploma of Adult Language, Literacy and Numeracy Leadership.
