Certificate IV in Training and Assessment *Job Trainer (Fee-Free Qualification)*

(Training under Job Trainer is fee-free and is fully funded by the NSW and Commonwealth Governments)

Course Description: This qualification reflects the roles of experienced practitioners delivering training and assessment services usually within Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) within the vocational education and training (VET) sector. They may have a role in leading other trainers and assessors and in providing mentoring or advice to new trainers or assessors as well as designing approaches to learning and assessment strategies across a significant area within the RTO.

Articulation: On completion of this course you would be able to consider higher qualifications such as: TAE50116 Diploma of Vocational Education and Training or TAE50216 Diploma of Training Design and Development.

Licensing/Regulatory Information: Achievement of this qualification by trainers is a requirement of the Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) 2015.

FEE-FREE—SKILLING FOR RECOVERY—JOB TRAINER



Fee-free training qualifications will support those most affected by current economic conditions to gain skills in priority and growth industry areas, so they can take advantage of future job opportunities as the economy recovers from the effects of COVID-19.

The Fee-Free training for a TAE qualification will apply to anyone who lives or works in NSW and who meet the Smart and Skilled eligibility criteria (see next page). Note: Aboriginal students and students with a disability, fee-free scholarship students and refugees and asylum seekers are eligible to access fee-free training for qualifications under Smart and Skilled.

Entry Requirements:

Those entering this program must be able to demonstrate vocational competency in their proposed teaching and assessing area. Vocational competency is defined as broad industry knowledge and experience, and may include, but is not limited to, holding a relevant unit of competency or qualification.

Cost: Fee-Free

The fee-free **Skilling for Recovery—Job Trainer** is available to those who live or work in **NSW** and meet one of the following criteria:

- Youth (Age 16—24)
- Unemployed (not a Commonwealth Benefit Recipient)
- Currently employed (seeking to undertake TAE qualifications)
- Commonwealth Benefit Recipient
- At risk of unemployment (people expected to become unemployed)
- A Veteran or a Veteran's Recognised Partner

Delivery Options:

Distance/Online delivery supported by Zoom workshops
Face-to-face workshops

Recommended Duration and Volume of Learning:

The volume of learning for the TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment as a Learning and Assessment pathway is typically six months to two years. (600 - 2400 hours). This may vary according to prior skills and knowledge.
