Entry Requirements

It is desirable that candidates are employed in a role where they have maintained currency within the VET (Vocational Education and Training) sector and have either TAE40110 or TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment.

Recommended Duration and Volume of Learning

The volume of learning for the Diploma of Training Design and Development as a Learning and Assessment pathway is typically 1 to 2 years (1200 – 2400 hours).
