Qualification: Certificate IV (NRT)

Training Package: TAE Training and Education Training Package

Course Description: This qualification reflects the roles of entry-level vocational education and training (VET) teachers, trainers and assessor who are delivering training services to vocational learners and assessment services to candidates. The roles may be undertaken by those working in registered training organisations (RTOs), enterprises, community organisations, schools and other VET provision contexts.

Articulation: On completion of this course you would be able to consider higher qualifications such as: TAE50122 Diploma of Vocational Education and Training.

Licensing/Regulatory Information: This qualification meets the minimum education requirement for trainers and assessors operating without supervision under applicable VET legislation, frameworks and/or standards.



COST: Student Fee will be calculated on registration/enrolment according to the **Government Smart and Skilled** funding calculation as follows:

- If it is your first qualification post School - **Estimated fee \$1,580**
- If it is your second or further qualification post School - **Estimated fee \$1,850**
- If you are a welfare recipient you may be eligible for a **concession fee of \$240**
- Fee-free training will still apply to Aboriginal students and students with a disability

To be eligible for a subsidised place you must meet the following criteria:

- Live or work in NSW
- Be an Australian Citizen, New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Australian Resident
