Course Description: This qualification reflects the roles of experienced individuals in a variety of vocational and training (VET) sector job roles, including:

Advanced training and assessment where individuals are responsible for delivering training and assessment services in the VET sector, including promoting innovative practices and leading other VET teachers, trainers and assessors.

Design and development job roles where individuals are responsible for designing and developing training and assessment strategies usually for registered training organisations (RTOs), including analysing training needs and designing training solutions and products to meet industry standards and compliance requirements.

VET leadership job roles where individuals are responsible for providing mentoring, guidance and advice to entry-level VET teachers, trainers and assessors, including supporting quality and compliance operations.

Entry Requirements: Must demonstrate current VET skills and knowledge relevant to the specialisation chosen in this qualification. You must have the TAE40116 or TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment as a pre-requisite to enrolling. You also need to be in a role where you are mentoring and supporting other trainers and assessors.

Recommended Duration and Volume of Learning: 1 to 2 Years (1200—2400 hours)



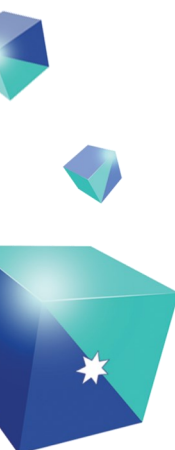
COST: Student Fee will be calculated on registration/enrolment according to the **Government Smart and Skilled** funding calculation as follows:

- If it is your first qualification post School - **Estimated fee \$2,530**
- If it is your second or further qualification post School - **Estimated fee \$2,850**
- Fee-free training will still apply to Aboriginal students and students with a disability

To be eligible for a subsidised place you must meet the following criteria:

- Live or work in NSW
- Be an Australian Citizen, New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Australian Resident
